One stamped 14KT yellow gold ladies hand assembled tanzanite and diamond ring with a tapered shank with a bright polish finish. Condition is good. One oval cut tanzanite is set in the top center using four prongs to hold the stone in an oval shaped base. The top of the ring shank, on each side of the major stone, has three channels with four round brilliant cut diamonds set in each of the six rows. Trademark is H.J.. Identified with markings of "14K". Containing:

Twenty-four prong set round brilliant cut diamonds, measuring 2.24 - 2.20 x 1.36mm (depth est.) approximate total weight of 24 Stones = 0.98ct. All diamonds were graded while set. Average estimated measurements were used to calculate the diamond weight by use of formulas. Color grade was estimated.
